2. Be conceived by a professional architectural or engineering firm or landscape designer.
3. Be installed by a professional fence contractor.

Criteria

Innovative design and installation of chain-link fence materials on a commercial, industrial, institutional, or sporting project

Entries will be accepted by mail or email.

Email entries will only be accepted in JPEG (.jpg) digital format. Digital images must not exceed a file size of 1MB.

Please note that Australian Chain-Link Fencing Association and Downee may contact winning entrant to obtain higher resolution images for inclusion in press release and magazine advertising. Australian Chain-Link Fencing Association and Downee reserve the right to showcase photography entries within their website as examples of entries and of their general web content.
